#### **FACILITIES**

- Calhoun: Tissue manufacturing and converting operation, pulp and paper mill (indefinitely idled)

esolute Forest Products' Calhoun mill, established in 1954, produces towel and tissue products for customers that include some of the country's largest retailers. Through the addition of the tissue operation at Calhoun, and in conjunction with additional tissue manufacturing and converting facilities in Florida and Maryland, Resolute is building a competitive integrated tissue business serving the North American market. In 2018, the mill added a new \$20-million distribution center to the operation.

## **Expanding in the Tissue Market**

Resolute's tissue operations in Tennessee, Maryland and Florida benefit from vertical integration. Tissue products are manufactured from virgin pulp or 100% recycled pulp sourced from the company's internal market pulp network. This approach allows for control over the production process—from material input to final product – ensuring precise control, cost competitiveness and consistent quality, while offering the flexibility and customization that customers demand.

## Supporting Sustainability

The Calhoun mill is committed to sustainability and has undertaken multiple initiatives:

- The Calhoun mill sources wood fiber and maintains chain-of-custody and controlled wood certificates under the standards of the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI®), the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) and the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®). In 2020, the mill's tissue operation integrated the company's multisite chain-of-custody certified fiber-tracking system for Resolute's network of tissue mills.
- Contributing to the company's success in reducing absolute direct and indirect greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions by 87% from 2000 levels, the mill has achieved an 93% reduction in scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions.

## Supporting Sustainability (Cont.)

- Mill employees completed 2022 without a single recordable injury, reaching 250,000 consecutive hours without a recordable injury. For every 250,000 injury-free hours, Resolute rewards employees with \$5,000 or more to donate to local organizations.
- The Calhoun operation is certified to the ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management Standard and the ISO 9001 Quality Management Standard.
- The mill sponsors an employee-driven "Goodfellows" program that provides Christmas baskets, coats and toys for needy individuals in the surrounding area.
