Resolute Forest Products owns two sawmill operations in Arkansas - one in Glenwood and the other in El Dorado. Resolute acquired both operations in February 2020, marking the company's entry into the wood products industry in the U.S. Resolute has extensive industry experience operating nearly 20 wood products facilities in Canada.

Glenwood Mill

The Glenwood sawmill produces Southern Yellow Pine dimensional lumber as well as radius edge decking used by the construction industry in the South Central U.S. The mill is well-positioned for growth, in close proximity to some of the highest population growth markets in the country.

El Dorado Mill

Resolute acquired the El Dorado sawmill in an idled state, restarting it in December 2020. The facility is currently undergoing significant capital improvement, and once fully operational, is expected to employ nearly 150 individuals and to produce up to 180 million board feet of dimensional lumber and specialty products.
